Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of our science topic on forces, Year 5 will be visiting Duxford Imperial War Museum on Tuesday 13th June 2017. We will be leaving school at 8.30am and aiming to return at 4.00pm. The children will need to wear their school uniform. Sensible shoes are necessary especially as we do a lot of walking around the site. Most activities will be indoors, however some of the day will be spent outside, therefore please ensure your child has a waterproof coat.

Each child will need a packed lunch with no fizzy drinks, glass bottles, nuts, chocolate or sweets in a named carrier bag. If your child receives free school meals the school can, upon request, provide them with a packed lunch and a small drink. Please advise the school office by 30 May 2017 if your child requires a packed lunch, they may also bring a drink with them.

To cover the cost of the trip we are requesting a voluntary contribution of £11.50. We will not exclude any pupil whose parent is unable or unwilling to contribute, however, we are sure you appreciate that trips cannot go ahead without your support.

Payment should be made for the trip via Parentmail by 13 June 2017. Please ensure that your child's medical information and emergency contact details are up to date. Should you need to amend any emergency contact details or medical information for the day of the trip please inform your child's class teacher. If you are not yet signed up to Parentmail, or experiencing difficulty signing up, please contact the school office and a member of staff will be available to assist you.

There is a gift shop at Duxford Imperial War Museum. Children are allowed to bring up to a maximum of £3.00 spending money. Please ensure that this is placed in a clearly labeled purse or wallet. This is essential due to the number of children from our school visiting the museum. Staff will not be able to lend children money if they do not bring any or children lose theirs. If your child suffers from travel sickness please give them a tablet BEFORE school and supply the class teacher with one to administer for the return journey. This should be in a sealed envelope, including the child's name, class and instructions for administering the tablet.
