<b>Mr Buttress</b>	(Butler) Suit jacket, shirt and trousers	
<b>Mrs Burnitt</b>	(Cook) White blouse, long skirt and apron.	Cook's hat, apron
<b>Ethel and Elsie</b>	(Maids) White blouse, black long skirt and apron.	
<b>Boots</b>	Suit jacket, shirt and trousers	
<b>Basil Bud</b>	(Gardener) Outdoor gardening clothes e.g. dungarees	
<b>Sid Saddle</b>	(Stable lad) Outdoor clothes, wellies, baggy trousers and rugged/tattered shirt.	
<b>Bernie Black</b>	(Chimney sweep) Dirty, ragged clothes. Shirt and shorts which are covered in soot.	
<b>Den Bones</b>	(Butcher) White jacket like a science lab coat. Plain white t-shirt and dark trousers.	Apron with blood stains.
<b>Phil Pie</b>	(Baker) White shirt and blue and white chequered trousers if possible. Baker's hat and apron if possible.	Baker's hat and apron.
<b>Ernie Churn</b>	(Milk farmer/farm hand) Rough and ragged shirt and trousers.	
<b>Ivor Gavel</b>	Suit jacket, shirt and trousers. Auctioneer mallet if possible.	Auctioneer mallet
<b>Inspector</b>	Long mac with shirt and dark trousers. 1920s style hat if possible.	1920s style hat
<b>Amelia Earhart</b>	Plain t-shirt and leggings. Flying hat if possible. Leather flying jacket if possible.	Boiler suit. Flying hat and 'Biggles' goggles. Leather flying jacket.
<b>Captain Alcock</b>	Plain t-shirt and trousers. Flying helmet and goggles if possible. Leather flying jacket if possible.	Boiler suit. Flying hat and 'Biggles' goggles. Leather flying jacket.
<b>Emily Pankhurst</b>	(Suffragette) Long-sleeved blouse (maybe embroidered), long pleated skirt with big hat with hat pin. Broach to fasten blouse. Shawl.	Basket

<b>Albert Einstein</b>	Suit and waistcoat with shirt and trousers.	
<b>Agatha Christie</b>	Smart clothes, jacket and formal skirt with hat – 1920s style.	
<b>Chorus (girls)</b>	A brightly coloured t-shirt (one colour and no writing or pictures) or a sparkly coloured t-shirt with plain, dark leggings or trousers. A flapper girl style headband with feather if possible.	
<b>Chorus (boys)</b>	White shirt or polo shirt with a collar and black trousers. Colourful tie.
