Dear Parents/Carers

As you are aware this Wednesday is Sports Day for Nursery. Morning nursery will take place at 10.15 – 11.15am and afternoon nursery will take place from 2.00pm – 3.00pm.

The following information is to help you to know what to expect.

## **Start Time**

Sports day begins as close to 10.15am / 2.00pm as we are able to arrange it. Therefore as parents/ grandparents/ carers attending the event, please arrive shortly after 10.00am or 1.45pm, and wait at the top of the field until you see your child's teacher and class arriving on the field. The entrance gates will be closed and locked promptly at 10.15am and 2.00pm.

Please follow your child's class to each event, to cheer on your child.

## **Clothing/ Kit**

Clothing for sports day is usual school PE kit. Please ensure your child has sun cream and a hat if it is hot, and a beaker of water to drink throughout the afternoon. Please ensure beakers are named. Please do not give your child additional sweets/ food/ drinks during the afternoon.

## **Toilets**

Please be aware that toilets will not be available for use by visitors to the school for safeguarding reasons. In an emergency, you will need to be escorted to and from the bathroom by a member of Gusford staff on duty. However, can we ask for your patience in waiting for somebody who is not allocated to a post for the running of event.

## **Final event**

At the end of the event the children will return to their classroom to collect their belongings and will be allowed to go home with you.

**Please remain on the field until the children have returned to the classroom.** Please leave the field promptly and go to the usual collection point for your child. To enable us to keep children safe, and not lose anyone, this is very important.
