Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 2 Boat Trip on 21rd June 2017

Just a reminder that this week we will be going on our boat trip. We do hope that we have a nice sunny day (and the forecast does look promising), however if the weather forecast is very windy or stormy we may need to review whether the trip commences. Any changes will be notified to you nearer the time. As not all the areas of the boat are undercover we do ask that the children be dressed appropriately. If the weather is wet or cold, children should wrap up warmly and wear waterproofs. Equally, if the weather is warm (and it looks like it might be very warm) this should be taken into account. Footwear should be sensible and comfortable. Please ensure they all have a towel and their PE kit in school that they can change into in case they get wet on the trip. We expect to be back at school around 14h00 but children will be picked up at normal time at the end of the day.

The children will require a packed lunch to take with them. If you have ordered a lunch from school it will be packed for them. Due to space and eating arrangements on the boat, the packed lunch needs to be in a disposable container/wrapping including their water or juice. Please write their name on the wrapping and bottle.

Here is just a reminder of the things to remember to bring/ wear on the school trip...

- ❖ A packed lunch (no nuts, chocolate or sweets please)
- ❖ Drinks (no glass bottles or fizzy drinks please)
- ❖ Practical clothing for a day outside – warm clothing and waterproofs if wet, and sunhats if hot. Please ensure that if it is a hot day, that children are covered appropriately from the sun, especially if they are fair-skinned.
- ❖ Sensible, comfortable shoes.
- ❖ Sun cream should be applied before children arrive at school please.
- ❖ Inhalers or medication if not currently held in school (please give directly to the class teacher).
